ME ACEP Treasurer Statement

I first became involved with the ACEP Maine chapter almost a year ago at the leadership and advocacy conference in DC, which helped me feel as if I were part of something impactful and important for the first time in my short career after residency. It's not that I do not feel important practicing emergency medicine at work, do not get me wrong – it can sometimes just be lonely practicing in rural Maine, as if you're bailing water from a boat alone without a captain, boat crew, or marine mechanics to address the underlying cause.

Being involved in Maine ACEP did not give me a whole boat crew or marine mechanics, but it helped to hear from others in a similar position and it reminded me of why I chose and love emergency medicine. I therefore believe in the work Maine ACEP does, and would love the opportunity to give back and be more involved with the organization that continues to help me feel connected to my peers across the state.

Incidentally I am currently in school part time completing a master's in business administration while I work full time as an EM physician, hoping it would help me better understand the business aspects of healthcare, and how those decisions can affect our patient's access to care. The course could otherwise be helpful in the role of a treasurer in managing cash flow, forecasting and even financial planning.

Dear Members of the Maine ACEP Board:

I have been a member of Maine ACEP since starting residency at Maine Medical Center in 2012. My wife and I moved to Portland because it seemed like a great place to live, and over time Maine has become our home. In the last 14 years I have practiced clinical emergency medicine at Central Maine Medical Center, York Hospital, and Mercy Hospital. At York Hospital, I also served for two and a half years in a leadership role as Chief of Emergency Medicine.

Maine ACEP has been an important part of my professional development. Since residency, I have attended Maine ACEP meetings including at Cabbage Island and the Regency in Portland, and in recent years have regularly attended the Leadership meetings.
